**Talia Hagerty** is a Research Fellow at the Institute for Economics & Peace, where she leads the institute's research on peace and citizen security in Latin America. With a background in economics, peacebuilding, and gender, Talia contributes to IEP's work on positive peace, gender security, and multidimensional solutions for a more peaceful and prosperous world.
